Health Restrictions

The same health restrictions are in place with all of our students, if students have a runny nose, sore throat or cold/flu like symptoms they need to undergo a COVID test and receive a negative result before they can return to school. All siblings must do the same and can't come back to school until a negative test is confirmed. If parents don't wish for their children to undergo a test they need to isolate at home for 14 days from that start of the symptoms.

Parents Visiting the School

Parents are now allowed to enter the school grounds but only to visit the office to either pick up & drop off students, to purchase uniforms or to organise school related matters with office staff. They can't go into classrooms and must move directly from the gate to the office both on arriving & when leaving the school grounds.

2020 End of Year Performance & Presentation Afternoon

Whilst COVID restrictions in schools have recently been eased slightly we will not be able to run our traditional Concert/Presentation evening in it's regular format. Whole School Swimming Program 2020

Our whole school K-6 will be involved in our Annual Intense Swimming program at the Echuca Indoor pool from Monday the 23rd to Friday the 27th of November.

Children will work at school from 9.20am - 11.20am in their classrooms each morning, before a shorter recess/lunch break from 11.20am - 11.45am where they will be able to eat before swimming.

We will depart on the bus from the school at 11.45am. On arrival in Echuca half of the students will be dropped at Apex Park whilst the other half will be dropped off at the pool, change & then swim from 12.30pm –1.00pm.

After a play the park group will walk to the pool, change & then swap over with the swimming group who will walk back to the park for a snack & a play. When the 2nd group finishes swimming they will change & then walk back to the park.

Parents who wish to pick children up can do so from Approximately 1.45pm at the park, which will help us to meet the pool's COVID restrictions.

Once pick ups are completed remaining children can finish eating & drinking & we will return to school by bus. We moved swimming times forward to help with the bridge crossing on the way home, unfortunately now this won't be a factor due to the border opening, but staff timetables at the pool have been completed so we will have to stick with the changed times.

Children will need to bring bathers, a towel & goggles each day. There will be no cost for families with the P & C paying bus costs and Murray Irrigation & the school sharing the cost of the actual lessons.

All families need to do is complete & return the attached permission note to the school ASAP.
