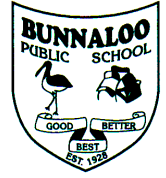

Bunnaloo P and C Fundraiser

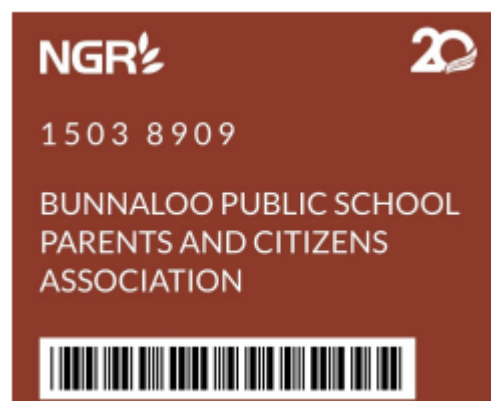
A message from the P & C,

Bunnaloo Public School has it's own NGR Card.

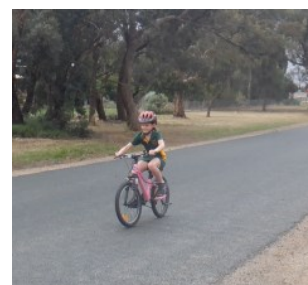
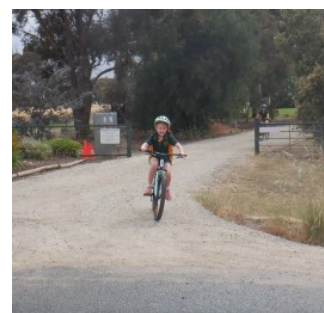
As a P & C we are asking for donations in tis upcoming harvest.
