So it is with great happiness that I would like to share with you that due to some outstanding support from the Conargo Community things have changed and we cab once again commit to the Narrabeen Excursion for the foreseeable future.

A number of years ago the Conargo Community received a large sum of money in a will from a former Conargo P.S student.

The committee who manage these funds has agreed to invest some of it in a fund that will cover all travel costs for Conargo/Blighty/Mayrung & Bunnaloo students into the future.

This year this was around \$8000. This will make the excursion very affordable into the future.
